

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Organizer Information

By accessing this website, submitting any registration form, purchasing any VIP ticket, or attending the Event, you agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.

2. Scope

These Terms & Conditions govern:

- a) use of the website;
- b) registration for free attendance;
- c) purchase and use of VIP tickets;
- d) attendance at and participation in the Event;
- e) access to the venue, track, paddock, hospitality and public areas; and
- f) all related communications, QR-based admission, media capture and event participation.

3. Definitions

For the purposes of these Terms:

- “Organizer” means AVALON FOX SLU.
- “Event” means Welcome Charity Day and all related activities, hospitality, public access, VIP access, track-related activities, karting, passenger rides, charity activations, entertainment and any ancillary programming.
- “Participant” means any person who registers, purchases a ticket, attends, enters the venue, or otherwise takes part in the Event.
- “Venue” includes the race track, karting area, paddock, pit-adjacent areas, terraces, parking, hospitality zones, access roads, entry points and any associated event area.
- “VIP Ticket” means any paid ticket or premium access pass issued by the Organizer.
- “QR Access” means the digital access credential issued by the Organizer for entry.

4. Event Nature

Welcome Charity Day is a public charity automotive event that may include, without limitation:

- public attendance;
- limited passenger rides;
- viewing of track activities;
- karting activities;
- hospitality and VIP access;
- charity-related presentations and activities;
- entertainment, music and sponsor activations.

The Event is not a transportation service, not a racing school, and not a guaranteed ride experience. Any specific activity, vehicle, driver, area access, or timetable may be modified, restricted or cancelled at the Organizer’s discretion.

5. Eligibility and Authority

By registering or attending, the Participant represents and warrants that:

- they have legal capacity to accept these Terms;
- the information submitted is true, accurate and complete;
- if registering any child or minor, they are the parent or lawful guardian authorized to do so;
- they will comply with all venue, safety and staff instructions.

The Organizer may refuse registration, deny entry, cancel access credentials, or remove any person from the Event at its sole discretion where necessary for safety, operational, legal or reputational reasons.

6. Registration, Approval and QR Access

6.1 Free registration and VIP registration are subject to validation and capacity.

6.2 Submission of a form does not guarantee admission.

6.3 Admission may require Organizer confirmation and issuance of a valid QR code or other access credential.

6.4 QR codes are personal, revocable, non-transferable unless expressly authorized by the Organizer, and may be invalidated in case of duplication, fraud, misuse, resale or breach of these Terms.

6.5 The Organizer may require identity verification at entry.

6.6 The Organizer may refuse entry where registration details are inaccurate, incomplete, inconsistent or suspicious.

7. Tickets and VIP Access

7.1 The Event may include both free and paid admissions.

7.2 All VIP purchases are final, subject only to mandatory applicable law.

7.3 Unless the Organizer expressly confirms otherwise in writing, VIP tickets are non-refundable, non-exchangeable and non-cancellable.

7.4 A VIP ticket grants only the access expressly described by the Organizer. It does not guarantee:

- any specific car;

- any specific driver;
- any ride;
- any exact schedule;
- uninterrupted access to all areas;
- any particular sponsor activation or entertainment segment.

7.5 The Organizer may modify VIP benefits, hospitality format, vehicle line-up, guest list, schedule or access flow if required for safety, logistics, operations, legal compliance or force majeure.

8. Pricing, Payment and Taxes

8.1 Prices are those displayed or communicated by the Organizer at the time of sale.

8.2 Payments may be processed through the Organizer's designated banking/payment method, including Caixa-linked payment flow where applicable.

8.3 The Participant is responsible for ensuring correct payment details and completion of payment.

8.4 The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or reject any booking affected by pricing error, suspected fraud, payment failure or unauthorized use.

9. Assumption of Risk

9.1 The Participant acknowledges that motorsport, trackside environments, karting areas, moving vehicles, supercars, hospitality near vehicle operations, crowd environments and event infrastructure involve inherent and significant risks.

9.2 These risks may include, without limitation:

- collision or vehicle incident;
- slips, trips and falls;
- mechanical failure;
- excessive noise;
- fire;

- crowd-related incidents;
- negligent acts of third parties;
- serious personal injury;
- property damage;
- disability; and
- death.

9.3 The Participant fully understands and voluntarily assumes all such risks, whether known or unknown, ordinary or extraordinary, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

10. Health, Fitness and Personal Responsibility

The Participant represents that they are physically and mentally fit to attend and, where applicable, to participate in any permitted activity.

The Participant agrees:

- not to enter restricted or active areas without authorization;
- not to participate if feeling unwell, impaired or unsafe;
- to immediately follow all staff, marshal, security, medical and venue instructions;
- not to interfere with drivers, vehicles, operations, event personnel or other attendees.

The Participant is solely responsible for their own decisions, conduct, safety and the consequences of attending or participating.

11. Passenger Rides and Activity-Specific Rules

11.1 Passenger rides, if offered, are limited, discretionary and subject to safety conditions, availability and organizer approval.

11.2 The Organizer may impose age, height, health, clothing, footwear or conduct restrictions.

11.3 Any refusal by staff or drivers is final.

11.4 The Participant must wear any required safety equipment and comply with all instructions.

11.5 The Organizer may suspend or terminate a ride or activity immediately for safety reasons.

12. Karting and Restricted Activity Areas

12.1 Karting and related areas are subject to separate venue rules, safety restrictions and operational conditions.

12.2 Free karting, if offered, is subject to capacity, eligibility, operating hours, queue management, safety approval and venue control.

12.3 The Organizer does not guarantee karting access to every attendee.

12.4 Entry to operational, technical, restricted or staff-only areas is prohibited unless expressly authorized.

13. Children and Minors

13.1 Minors may attend only under the responsibility and continuous supervision of a parent or legal guardian.

13.2 Registration of minors must be completed by the parent or legal guardian.

13.3 The parent/guardian accepts full responsibility for the minor's conduct, supervision, safety and compliance with these Terms.

13.4 Minors must not be left unattended at the Venue.

13.5 The Organizer may deny or remove any minor from any area or activity for safety reasons.

13.6 The parent/guardian acknowledges that the Venue includes inherently dangerous automotive and track-related environments and expressly accepts such risks on behalf of themselves and the minor to the maximum extent permitted by law.

14. Conduct and Removal

The Participant must behave safely, respectfully and lawfully at all times.

The following may result in immediate refusal of entry or removal without refund or compensation:

- dangerous conduct;

- intoxication or suspected impairment;
- harassment, aggression or threats;
- damage to vehicles, venue or property;
- breach of staff instructions;
- unauthorized access to restricted areas;
- misuse of QR codes/tickets;
- commercial solicitation without permission;
- conduct that may harm the Event, its reputation, participants, sponsors or partners.

15. Liability Limitation

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the Organizer, its officers, employees, contractors, sponsors, drivers, partners, venue operators, service providers and affiliates shall not be liable for:

- personal injury;
- death;
- loss;
- theft;
- delay;
- disruption;
- cancellation;
- property damage;
- indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages;
- acts or omissions of third parties;
- participant misconduct;

- vehicle-related incidents;
- venue restrictions;
- force majeure events.

Nothing in these Terms excludes liability where liability cannot be lawfully excluded under mandatory applicable law.

16. Indemnity

The Participant agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Organizer and its related parties from and against claims, liabilities, damages, losses, fines, costs and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) arising out of:

- breach of these Terms;
- negligent or unlawful conduct of the Participant;
- misuse of the Event, venue or website;
- damage caused by the Participant or persons under their responsibility, including minors.

17. Personal Belongings and Vehicles

The Organizer is not responsible for loss of, theft of, or damage to:

- personal belongings;
- vehicles;
- items left in vehicles;
- helmets, clothing, cameras, phones or equipment;
- property entrusted to third parties.

All parking and vehicle attendance is at the owner's/user's own risk unless expressly agreed otherwise in writing.

18. Event Changes, Suspension or Cancellation

The Organizer may at any time and without prior notice:

- amend the program;
- change schedules;
- replace or remove activities;
- modify access areas;
- restrict attendance;
- suspend or cancel all or part of the Event.

This may occur due to safety, weather, force majeure, legal requirements, operational issues, venue decisions, driver availability, technical issues, low attendance, sponsor requirements or other reasons reasonably affecting the Event.

Except where mandatory law requires otherwise, the Organizer shall not be liable for related costs, losses or expectations.

19. Force Majeure

The Organizer shall not be liable for failure or delay caused by events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to:

- severe weather;
- natural events;
- fire;
- flood;
- accident;
- war;
- civil unrest;
- epidemic/pandemic restrictions;

- transport disruption;
- power/infrastructure failure;
- government action;
- venue shutdown;
- supplier or contractor failure.

20. Photography, Video and Publicity Release

By attending the Event, the Participant grants the Organizer and its designees the irrevocable right to photograph, film, record and use their image, likeness, voice, statements and appearance for:

- advertising;
- promotion;
- social media;
- press;
- sponsorship materials;
- website use;
- future event promotion;
- archival and documentary purposes,

worldwide, in any media, without further consent, notice or compensation.

If a Participant submits, tags or shares event-related content, the Organizer may repost, reuse or reference such content in connection with the Event and its promotion, unless the Participant explicitly objects in writing and the Organizer is legally required to honor such objection.

21. Website Use

The website and its contents are provided for informational and registration purposes.

The Participant agrees not to:

- misuse the site;
- attempt unauthorized access;
- upload malicious material;
- scrape, copy or commercially exploit content without permission;
- interfere with forms, ticketing or QR systems.

22. Intellectual Property

All website materials, branding, event names, logos, graphics, texts, images, videos and related content are owned by or licensed to the Organizer or relevant rights holders.

No reproduction, distribution, republication or commercial use is permitted without prior written consent.

23. Privacy and Data

Use of personal data is governed by the Organizer's Privacy Policy. By submitting data, the Participant confirms that:

- the submitted data is accurate;
- they are authorized to submit it;
- they have read and accepted the Privacy Policy;
- where minors are involved, the parent/guardian is the person submitting the data and authorizing the processing as required.

24. Severability

If any provision of these Terms is found invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

25. No Waiver

Failure by the Organizer to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of that provision or any other rights.

26. Entire Agreement

These Terms, together with the Privacy Policy and any specific ticketing or registration terms expressly issued by the Organizer, constitute the entire agreement between the Participant and the Organizer regarding the Event and website use.

27. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms shall be governed by the laws of Spain.

Any dispute arising from or in connection with these Terms shall be submitted to the courts legally competent under applicable law. If legally permissible and where consumer protections do not require otherwise, venue shall be Barcelona, Spain.

28. Language

These Terms may be published in more than one language. In the event of discrepancy, the version designated by the Organizer as controlling shall prevail.
